2. A true copy of transcripts from your high school if you are a graduating senior. If you are presently enrolled in a college or university, submit a true copy of your cumulative records.
3. Two current letters of reference from persons other than relatives. If you are a previous HARVEST recipient, include one letter of reference.
4. The financial portion of this application must be filled out completely.
5. The application must be signed by the applicant. In addition, if you have included your family's financial information, the application must also be signed by your parent/guardian.
