- ✓ Members agree to engage in conduct and actions that promote and enhance the public image of manufactured housing and manufactured housing communities, bringing respect, credibility, and prestige to the Association and the industry.
- ✓ Members agree to engage in conduct and actions that respect the interests of customers, residents, vendors, and the public regarding the manufactured housing industry and the manufactured housing community lifestyle.
- ✓ Members agree to promote positive customer and resident relations as an essential responsibility.
- ✓ Members agree to promote industry products and services that contribute to the health, welfare, and best interests of customers and residents, including high standards of construction, great value, and quality community living.
- ✓ Manufactured housing community owners shall subscribe, in principle and practice, to respect their responsibilities to the residents within their communities and shall maintain communities in such a fashion as to constructively improve the public image of manufactured housing living and ensure sanitary, healthy, quality community living.
- ✓ Members agree to promote products and services honestly and without false premise or misrepresentation.
- ✓ Members agree to conduct themselves in a professional, courteous, and considerate manner in communications and interaction with other members, residents, vendors, the media, policymakers, and the public.
- ✓ Members agree to adhere to all applicable state and federal laws and regulations affecting the manufactured housing industry.
- ✓ Members agree to be bound by this Code of Professional Conduct, as well as MMHA Bylaws, as a condition of membership.
